This project has been funded by the Action 2 Interagency Global Programme on Strengthening UN Support for the Promotion and Protection of Human Rights Worldwide.

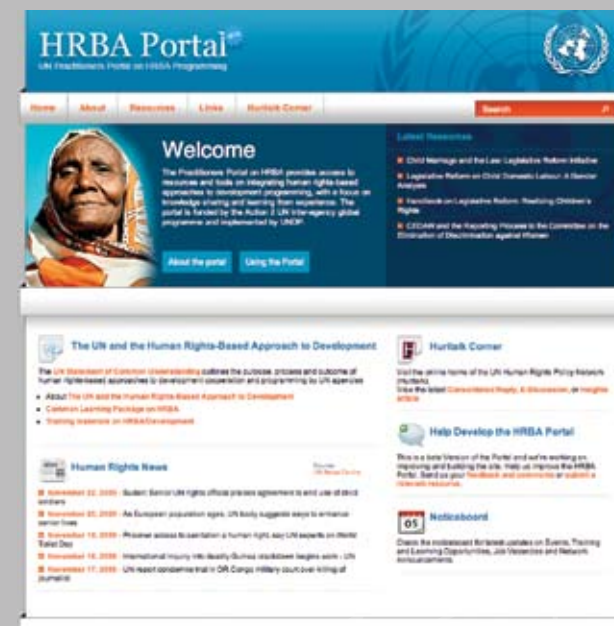

## Key Features



**HRBA and the UN System:** Information on the UN Common Understanding on HRBA, the Common Learning Package on HRBA and the 2009 Guidelines for programming HRBA into the Common Country Assessment / United Nations Development Assistance Framework.

**Resource Database:** Browse or search for resources including relevant international standards, 'how-to guides', manuals, case-studies and learning materials.

**Huritalk Corner:** Human Rights Policy Network (Huritalk) corner provides examples of practical experience and lessons-learned on HRBA made available in easily accessible knowledge products.

**Noticeboard:** Information on upcoming events, trainings, job vacancies and announcements.

**Interactive Features:** Users can comment on and rate resources, and bookmark or share resources.

## Resources Page



The resources page provides access to practical tools, case-studies, publications and learning materials, accessible through various entry points. Search by:

- **Resource type** (case study, publication, learning material).
- **Region** (select one or multiple regions).
- **Programming Cycle** (budgeting, monitoring and evaluation).
- **Topic** (19 thematic areas covered).

Each page links to relevant information including international human rights standards, special procedures and relevant organizations including UN agencies and NGOs.

The Huritalk Corner provides examples of practical experience and lessons-learned shared by members on the UN Human Rights Policy Network. Practitioners may search for archived consolidated replies and e-discussions in this password-protected section of the portal.
